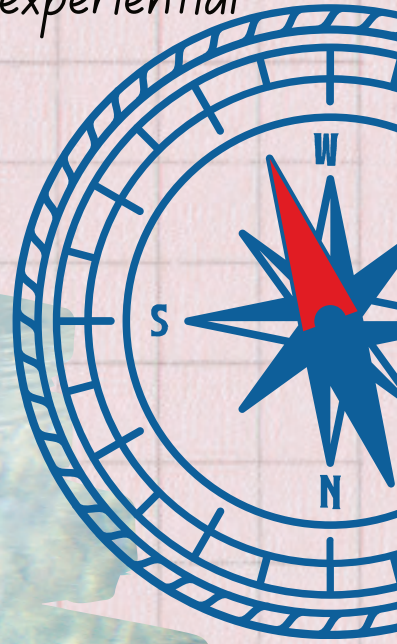
FUN ENGLISH

FUN ENGLISH



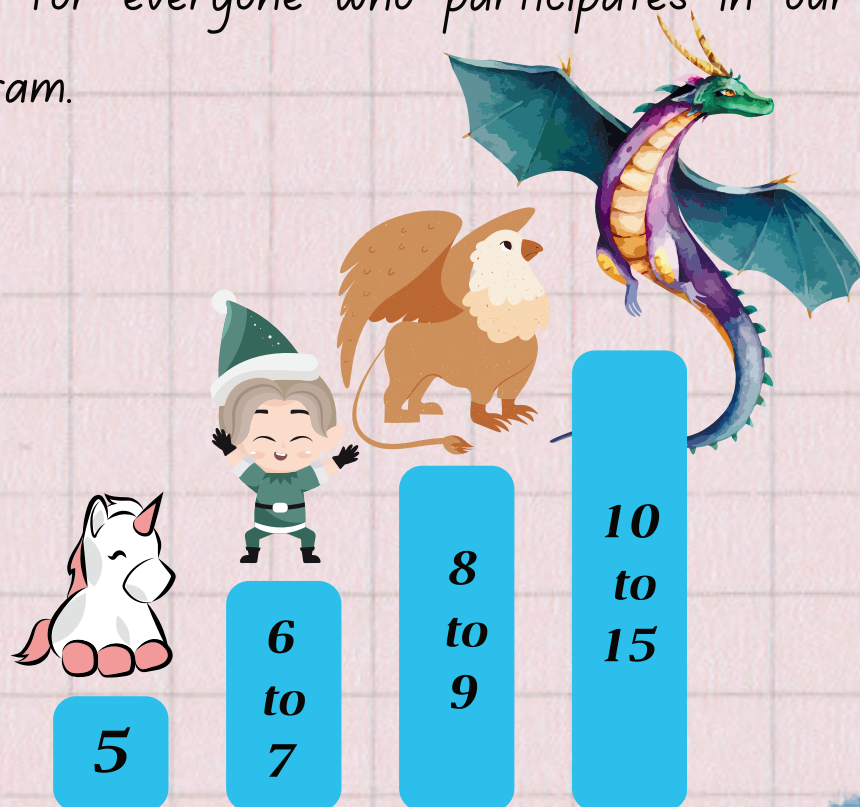
CREATE

FOOD

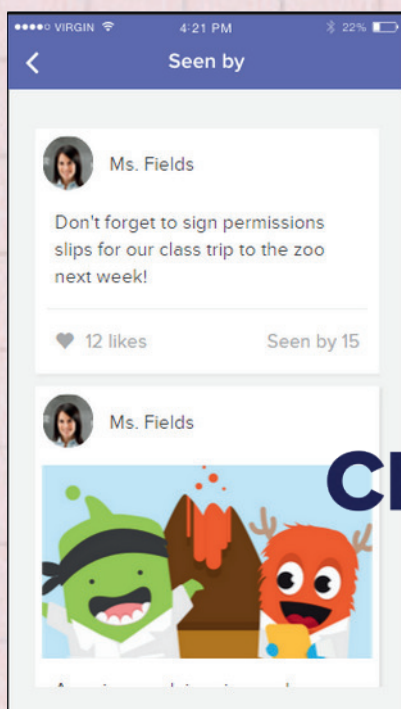

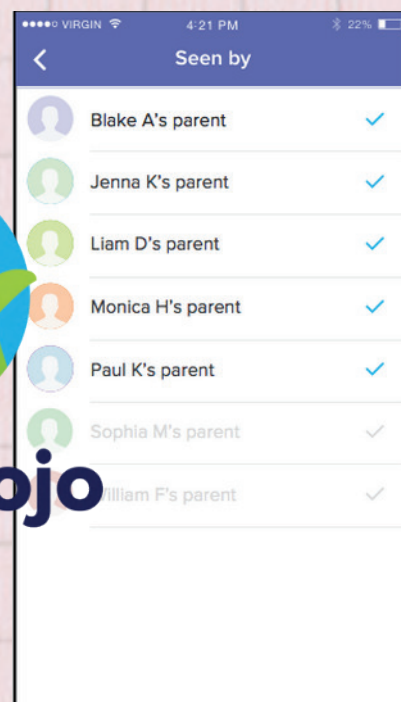
COMMUNICATION
